

Locarno in Los Angeles 2020: Homecoming

Welcome to the fourth edition of Locarno in Los Angeles. This year we return to the Downtown Independent, home of the festival's first two editions. We hope you enjoy the communal atmosphere this location provides, and the post-screening events we have planned nearby.

The 72nd Locarno Film Festival marked the first under new artistic director Lili Hinstin. We're happy to say that the adventurous and diverse Locarno sensibility that we've come to love and admire shows no signs of waning under Hinstin's leadership. Even a brief glance at our program confirms as much: in addition to such radical new voices as Minh Quý Trương (THE TREE HOUSE), Maya Kosa and Sérgio da Costa (BIRD ISLAND), Matjaž Ivanišin (OROSLAN), Eloy Enciso (ENDLESS NIGHT), and Jessica Sarah Rinland (THOSE THAT, AT A DISTANCE, RESEMBLE ANOTHER), there are also familiar names like Ben Rivers and Anocha Suwichakornpong (KRABI 2562), Kōji Fukada (A GIRL MISSING), and Ulrich Köhler and Henner Winckler (A VOLUNTARY YEAR).

Our opening and closing night selections are both films by emerging artists of extraordinary imagination: Tyler Taormina's HAM ON RYE, an L.A. shot coming-of-age drama starring over 100 performers, including first-time actors and 90's Nickelodeon child stars, will open this year's edition with the director on hand to discuss the making of this very personal work, while Elsa Kremser and Levin Peter's stunning sci-fi docufiction SPACE DOGS will close things out with its unique blend of earthbound action and cosmic canine wonder.

Winner of both the Golden Leopard and Best Actress prizes at last summer's Locarno festival, the film tells the tragic story of Vitalina, a Cape Verdean woman who arrives three days late to her estranged husband's funeral in Lisbon. At once a refinement and a brave expansion of Costa's formal and thematic arsenal, VITALINA VARELA is an instant landmark in cinema history, a masterpiece that speaks to its maker's unparalleled sensitivity and stylistic acumen. We're thrilled to welcome Costa to the festival for his first presentation of a new work in Los Angeles in over a decade.

Lastly, we'd like to extend our gratitude to our loyal sponsors and partners, without whom this festival would not be possible. First and foremost, thank you to Lili Hinstin and the Locarno Film Festival for their ongoing support.
